

SCOUT BASIC #3 ~ THE FRANKENMUTH SCOUT HOUSE

January 13, 14, 15, 2012

This campout is for those scouts who are working on First Aid requirements for 2nd and 1st Class, and will lead right into First Aid Merit Badge. The focus of activities will be on First Aid!

And...for those older scouts who would like to take Fire Safety Merit Badge – this is an opportunity for you to complete 75% of the requirements for this merit badge on Saturday. The rest would require a visit with the merit badge class to a Livonia Fire Station to finish the badge.

And...for those older scouts who are completing Camping Merit Badge – this is an opportunity to complete your review of the First Aid necessary for Camping, and to get it signed off with Mr. Seay.

If you are interested in doing this, you must get the approval to participate from Mr. Bill Dobson or Mr. Jim Seay. One of them must sign your campout permission slip before you can sign up to go.

This campout has been both in 40 degree weather, as well as in snow, in the past, so be prepared. We will leave the church at 6:30 p.m. on Friday, January 13, and leave The Scout House in Frankenmuth at 9:00 a.m. on Sunday, January 15, 2012.

The cost of the campout for scouts, and/or parents, including the rental of the cabin is \$25 each. Dinner on Saturday night at the Bavarian Inn in Frankenmuth, increased the cost of this campout by \$3 each. The campout fee and permission blank are due back on Dec. 19th, or on Jan. 9th. We will also need seven or eight scouts who are patrol leader/troop guides or in TLC positions who want to help out in the kitchen, put on a campfire Saturday night, and to provide leadership to the group. If you are interested, contact Mr. Bill Dobson or Mr. Jim Seay, for approval to participate.
