

# SCOUT BASIC #1 OVERNIGHT

*Bishop Lake, Brighton Recreation Area*



Scout Basic #1 will be held on **September 24 and 25, 2011.**

The permission slip and \$17 are due at the meeting on September 19. **We will** meet at Holy Trinity **at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday**, and drive to the Organizational Campsite at Bishop Lake in Brighton Recreation area for the campout. Maps will be available at that time.

Scout Basic #1 is one of the four campouts set aside for new scouts to learn/be instructed and advance through many of the basic scouting skills. We will leave Bishop Lake by 11:00 a.m. on Sunday, and boys will be returned to their homes.

**Be sure to bring warm clothing, warm bedding, a ground cloth and poncho/rain gear.** Since we will be hiking in, you will need to pack your belongings in a backpack that you either have, or can borrow from a friend or older scout. You can also roll everything in your bedroll and tie the ends together so it is like a big horseshoe over your chest and shoulders. **THERE IS A \$10.00 FEE FOR ADULTS, as well as the daily vehicle entry permit fee for each car, if you don't have a 2011 Michigan State campground sticker.** (The day pass charge will be collected either upon entrance to the park, or by a park ranger during the day – in the campground.)
