

STERLING STATE PARK
MONROE, MICHIGAN
September 9, 10, 11, 2011

With Lake Erie and two miles of sandy beach at our doorstep, this should be a fun campout for all, and we urge any parents interested, to come with us for the weekend - it will be a good time, and we need parents for transportation and help, too. In mid-morning, we'll travel into Perrysburg, Ohio to visit the historic Fort Meigs, built at the start of the War of 1812 with England. We'll see the reconstructed fort, and the museum.

If warm weather stays with us, we plan on swimming on Saturday afternoon, after our 2.9 mile hike on the paved Marsh Trail (which circles one of the marsh lagoons). If you don't want your son in the water, please make such a notation on the permission slip. Our regular swimming precautions will be in effect, and an adult will always be present before any scout can go in the water.

The weather can be quite cold in the late evening, and early morning, so be sure to bring your warm clothing and bedding, as well as a poncho or raincoat! Camping fees are \$7 per person, per night, and are included in the campout fee. Vehicles must either have a valid State of Michigan State Parks sticker, or purchase one for \$24, or purchase two day passes for \$6 each day. Vehicle costs are **not** included in the campout fee. This is a good time for Camping M B scouts to get two nights of scout tent camping. Fee is \$25 per scout or adult, due Tuesday, September 6, 2011. Check payable to: **Troop #782**
