



TROOP 782 ~ TURKEY BOWL CAMPOUT
November 11, 12, 13, 2011 Pioneer Scout Reservation - Ohio

This big Thanksgiving Campout is an annual event in #782, complete with roasted turkeys, all the fixin's, and even baked-from-scratch pumpkin/cherry/apple pies. Many of your dads may wish to go along, but due to the cost of the cabins and dining hall, we will need to charge them, too. We will leave Holy Trinity at 6:30 p.m. on Friday, and leave Pioneer Scout Reservation by 10:00 a.m. on Sunday. The cost of the campout, including the facilities, is **\$25 per scout, or dad**. The campout fee and permission form are due on Oct. 24 or on Oct.31, or at the Court of Honor on Monday, Nov. 7.. **THE FIRST 90 SIGN-UPS WILL HAVE BEDS, OR MATTRESSES ON THE FLOOR, THE REST WILL NEED TO BRING COTS OR USE THEIR POLYPADS ON THE FLOOR!**

The Turkey Bowl Campout is always a fun event. The Saturday program will take you out into the woods and fields for a good time and we'll use the Bowman apple press and make our own apple cider. The big feature of the afternoon on Saturday is our annual football game with fathers and sons. *Some of the "fit" dads can hardly wait for this one!* In addition to the Turkey Bowl, we'll also have a Gible Bowl for the smaller/younger boys and any visiting Webelos. **For Webelos or Webelos' parents, or #782 scouts who only come up for the day on Saturday, the fee is \$18.00.**

SCOUT UNIFORM TO BE WORN FRIDAY NIGHT AND SUNDAY MORNING.

You need to bring: Scout book/paper/pencil; flashlight; sleeping bag/warm blankets; **change of shoes/clothing**; sleepwear; poncho/raincoat; change of underwear/socks; soap/toothbrush/paste; boots; warm jackets/hat/gloves; polypad, if necessary. (No spending money is needed.)

If you still need to carry your pack in, and sleep out in a tent one night to complete your camping for First Class, ~ or you want two more nights in a tent for Camping Merit Badge, tell Mr. Dobson and/or Mr. B ahead of time, and we'll arrange for some tents and plan that into our program. There will be no outdoor cooking on this campout.
